



■ **YEAR ROUND STRUCTURE**

Provide structure by clipping evergreen bushes into egg shapes. Evergreens are important in terms of positive energy because they look good at all times of the year. At Resting Laurels the evergreens help to screen the productive vegetable cage.



■ **WIND CHIMES**

Sounds made by wind chimes create vortices to take away negative energy, Paul believes, and he has placed several of them around his garden. There are also 22 seats strategically dotted about to catch the sun as it moves around.



■ **FULL CIRCLE**

Cut circles around carefully clipped shrubs. This creates a vortex that removes negative energy says Paul, who is convinced that his floriferous camellia proves the point.

■ **ZEN PATCH**

The sunken area, known as the "Zen Patch", is home to one of three water features surrounding the house, all of which are said to break down negative energy. The look is complemented by other oriental influences such as the use of gravel to suggest a stream and an acer.
